She was recently honored with the BeeBee Castro Award by Anne Arundel County Recreation and Parks for sportsmanship, positive coaching and creating opportunities for young women in sports. Currently the President of Integrity Lacrosse, a local grassroots youth club program, Coach Leavitt has a long record of attaining immediate results from players of all abilities.
